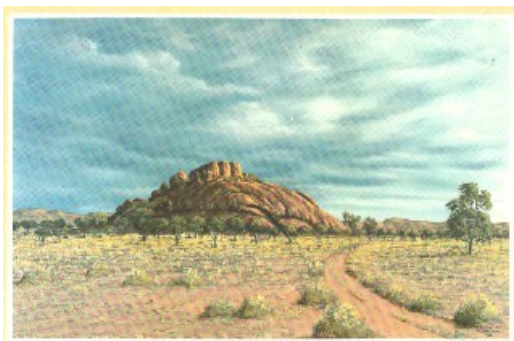

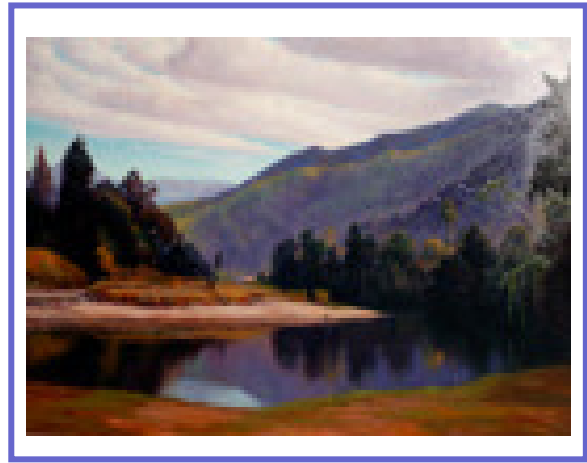
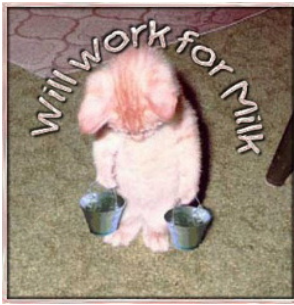
Jack Absalom Australia 1927 -

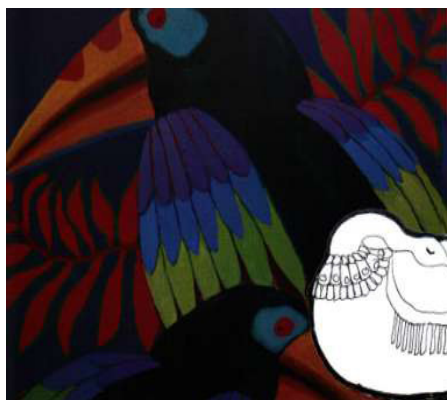

by making quirky ceramic birds. We hope to see a lot of people there during October. Graeme usually sells most of his work. These are not your standard birds at all.

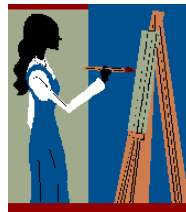
CAS Exhibition update.....

ATELIER ACRYLIC PAINT ..by Jacqueline Waters.
Each year I produce a few paintings. Currently the range of Atelier Interactive Acrylic paints is performing quite well for me. Please be vigilant when you buy a product that is not satisfactory and return it with your written issues to Chroma Australia. They won't know unless the public report back to them. Paint being an organic substance is prone eventually to the effects of aging. Chroma will always replace paint that is found to be faulty within 2 years of manufacture. They won't reimburse you for an old half used tube. Acrylic paints do have a limited life. Different pigments with binders such as cadmiums can be more of a problem. It seems that a "use by date" cannot be stipulated due to the different quality of pigments used between colours. For example some paints could last more than 10 years whilst others only a few years. Happy painting!
